Sharon Dixon opened meeting

Joe Miller & Lynn Westbrook w/JAXPORT updated us on the delivery of the 2 new cranes to Bl. Island. The cranes should be operational in approximately 30 days.

Doug Straatsma w/CBP advised that AMS will soon start transmitting through ACE. Jax CBP will have an officer going for training on 10/17/11. In November, should we start seeing releases not downloading to please give him a call.

Gail McMillen w/CBP said the new bond form 301 will go into effect at the beginning of next year. Rejects/Resolution requests are not being returned timely and CBP will start issuing liquidated damages for those. If there are reasons that they can not be returned within the allotted time, please make your request for extension in writing. Please make sure that you return the original 7501 along with the corrected 7501 and the reject/resolution sheet. She also said that documents were being put in the wrong boxes and to please remind our messengers to ensure they are putting documents in the correct boxes.

Lisa Weldon w/JAXPORT introduced herself, spoke briefly about FTZ and said there were still a few spots left for the "Doing Business with P.R." on 9/29/11 for \$30.00.

Carolyn Ryals w/FDA gave out handouts with Affirmation of Compliance codes and information. She advised that CBP will supervise exports of refused FDA products sending copies of everything to FDA once it's complete. FDA will supervise all destruction of refused FDA products and copies of documents sent to CBP once completed. She also said to make sure that we are using all necessary Affirmation of Compliance codes required and if the shipper is different from the manufacturer, we should report both registration numbers. If you are seeing "Documents required" frequently you may want to check to see what the issue is, some information may be reported incorrectly.

Debbie McDowell w/ICS spoke about the "Bring the Noise" Campaign which concerns supporting the port in many different ways by the community. There will be a Sister City festival on 9/24/11 and a rally on 10/6/11 concerning port deepening. Contact her for additional information.

Jim McLaughlin w/JMTX reminded us of the upcoming golf tournament on 10/26/11.
