Sharon Dixon opened meeting

Introductions of attendees

Sharon introduced Doug Straatsma w/CBP

Doug spoke on issues w/ISF, gov't repealing requirement for the port authority badge in addition to the TWIC badge (even though it was stated that they were still being used but they would no longer require finger-printing and cost of renewal is less), and the re-organization of the FTZ (now includes many surrounding counties).

Then Karol Palenik w/CBP was introduced. Karol spoke on various requirements for importation of vehicles and reminded everyone that DOT/EPA forms must be completed in full & correctly. He also gave examples of when EPA/DOT forms were needed and informed that the HS-7 can be filed electronically.

George Klinger with the URS Corp. was introduced next and his company has been contracted by the JMTX for work on the resumption of trade plan for the ports of Jacksonville & Fernandina Beach.
